With the works of the most prominent authors in the field of stories, dramas and novels.	
Purpose of the course:	To provide students with general knowledge about the context, about the phases, about the trends, about the structures, about the values and about the authors, whose works have played a determining role in the development of the structure of Albanian literature in the period after the Second World War World until now days.
