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Course description:	The Contemporary Albanian Literature I (poetry) is about the elaboration of the subject related to the conditions and circumstances in which this poetry literature was developed, the geographical extent from the beginning of this period (after the Second World War) onwards.		
Purpose of the course:	To provide students with general knowledge about the context, about the phases, about the trends, about the values and about the authors, whose works have played a defining role in the development of Albanian literature in the period from after the Second World War to the present. An effort should be made for students individually or in groups to research the phenomena, works and authors themselves through an interactive approach.		
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Learning outcomes:	- forms the idea for the general map (relief) of literary developments within the Albanian space after the Second World War and onwards. - acquires information and demonstrates knowledge about today's Albanian poetry - shows skills for critical reading as well as critical-analytical writing - uses the method of research and research for authors belonging to this literary period - identifies the most qualitative methods in the interpretation of the poetry of the authors of today's Albanian literature.
