Course description:	The course aims to deal first with the analysis of linguistic errors, focusing on the characteristics of grammatical errors of the German language and clarifying the grammatical difficulties of the German language.		
Purpose of the course:	Course objectives: Special emphasis is given to the development of the four integrated language skills through a communicative approach to language learning. Students develop the ability to use language structures correctly, fluency in speaking and the choice of appropriate language, practicing the language in situations with real-life content.		
Learning outcomes:	At the end of the semester, students will be able to identify the main purpose and details related to verbal communication; express ideas and thoughts clearly and efficiently, using appropriate grammatical expressions and appropriate vocabulary; develop critical thinking and analytical skills.
