Course Description:	Since Essay is the scientific discipline on the essay, the structure of the essay, its types, theoretical and methodological problems, the program of this subject contains the treatment of the creative process of the essay as a separate literary type, with the techniques, structure, themes and construction details. The program will also focus on writing techniques, spelling and essay structure. It will deal with all types of essays and their classifications, but the emphasis will be more on literary essays and occasionally these types will be concretized with examples from the essays of prominent Albanian and foreign essayists. In this way, students will have a clearer view of the birth, development and importance of essays in the development of thought and culture in general.			
Course objectives:	The purpose of the course is for students to become familiar with the uniqueness of the essay as a type of writing, with the most successful models of essay writing, with the means of expression, with its dual character of literature-science, etc. Then learn to write the essay, to know the models of writing the essay in the Albanian language, etc.			
Expected results:	During and after completing this course, students will be able to: • recognize the essay as a special type of writing that incorporates the literary and scientific aspect; • describe the developmental path of the essay and essay writing in general; • distinguish essays from one another and classify them according to topic and purpose; • write different types of essays

Fourteenth Week:	Literary and evaluative essays. Characteristics, purpose and use. (Examples from foreign and Albanian essayists).	Readings from literary essays and evaluations and discussions about the realization of their purpose.
Fifteenth Week:	Second evaluation test	Discussions and consultations about the results achieved.
